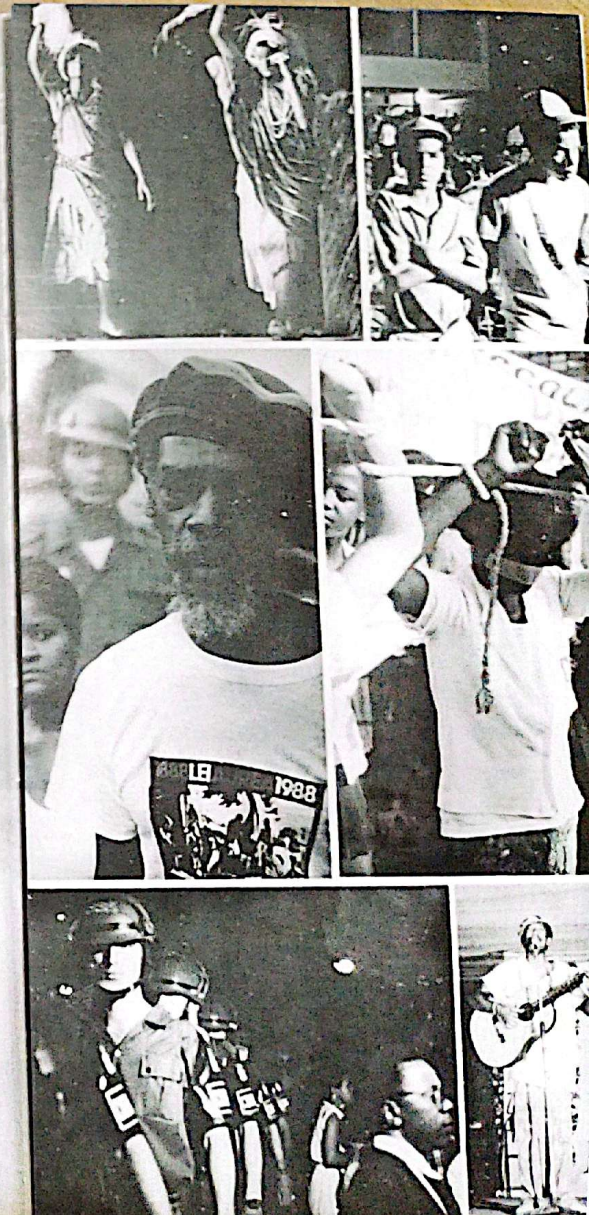

The One Hundredth Anniversary Of Abolition: Images, The Written Word, Events.

The year 1988 marked the one hundredth anniversary of the abolition of slavery in Brazil. Understanding the importance of this moment in the life of present-day Brazilian society, The Center for Interdisciplinary Studies (CIEC), organized a nationwide team of researchers whose goal was to collect materials and document events relating to this yearlong commemoration. The result is the Abolition Centennial Archive, a uniquely comprehensive collection of books, pamphlets, periodicals, handbills, posters, photographs, videotapes - in sum 8,913 items, which together constitute an impressive corpus of research materials on the centennial itself and a host of related issues. The events covered total 2,638 and include both official - that is, government-sponsored - and unofficial responses to the occasion.

CIEC invites scholars, students, and interested members of the general public to make use of the archive. The archive is open from 9am to 5pm and is located on the Praia Vermelha Campus of the Federal University. For more information write to:
